Youth Gathering What is the "youth gathering" that keeps being mentioned?



Bob McConnell called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

Devotions were led by Pastor John

Erin Dukart moved, and Michelle Mielke second, a motion to approve the December 19, 2023 minutes. Motion passed. One clerical error was noted in the misspelling of Denise MacDonalds name in section 6, subsection b, item ii.

Judy Kudrna gave a detailed explanation of the Financial Statement to help everyone understand how to read and follow the Statement as well as the understanding of how to make note of the correct account number to reference when submitting to Jessica any expenses. She said each team chair will receive their team report from Jessica each month to show how their finances are being used and the amount they have remaining. Rod Kudrna moved and Erin Dukart second a motion to accept the Financial Statement. Motion passed.

New Business:

Devotions Schedule- The 2024 Devotions Schedule, as well as the Council Meeting Schedule, were handed out. A few changes were made. Amanda Gill was removed and Craig Nelson was substituted for the August 20 devotions. Pastor Beth will do the March 19 devotions in place of Michelle Mielke.

Paying Bills- It was brought to council members attention that there are blue folders in the team mailboxes to submit any expenses to Jessica. Please note the account # to attribute it to which can be found on any Financial Statement.

Due Dates- Team Reports are due to Jessica the Friday prior to the Council meeting. Bulletin announcements are due Thursday by 12:00pm for the next Sunday. Newsletter announcements are due by the 20th of the month prior to the newsletter date. The newsletter is a bi-monthly newsletter.

Team Rosters- It was requested that all teams update their rosters, including email, for all members.

New Council - Installation of new council will be Sunday, February 25 at both services as well as Wednesday, February 28.

Camp of the Cross Annual Meeting- Lord of Life has 4 votes available, Arlys and Mike Malarkey will be attending. 2 more spots available. Tammie Sauer may be able to attend, Lora Isakson will be asked as well. Zoom attendance is a possibility.

Youth Team-Randy Binegar moved, Erin Dukart second to accept Amanda Gill's resignation as Youth Team Council and appoint Craig Nelson as Council member. Craig Nelson would be removed as Team Chair, to be replaced by Amber McGuire. Motion Passed.

CCO Team Concerns- The Larks game listed should read May 30 at 6:30 pm. A great discussion about the AED took place. It was brought to everyone's attention that the battery should be replaced every 5 years and the pads replaced every 2 years. Denise MacDonald mentioned her willingness to do a few trainings a year on how to use the blood pressure cuff and pulse oximeter. CPR classes were mentioned. ND Safety Council was brought up as a possible contact for them. Tammie Sauer offered to contact her friend who works there to find out any info.

Property Team- Rod Kudrna mentioned the emergency lighting updates Property Team is working on. No word yet from Don about an estimate of the elevator installation, but he has been out of town so this is to be expected.

Lenten Meal instructions will be posted in the kitchen so all groups will know what to look for and what to do. There is now a spiral notebook to record details for each meal to be able to look back on. (attendance, meal type, what was purchased, what is needed, what worked, what didn't, etc.)
